Description

On October 11-13, 2023, the "the Holocaust as a Starting Point" seminar was held at POLIN Museum in Warsaw, Poland. It was co-organized by the International Commission (Lithuania) represented by Ingrida Vilkiene, POLIN Museum (Poland) represented by Katarzyna Kulinska and the Mémorial de la Shoah (France) represented by Bruno Boyer and Zélie Daull.

During two days and a half, 55 participants followed a training including historical lectures, pedagogical workshops and a historical visit of the sites of Warsaw ghetto, the visit of the synagogue and of the temporary exhibition of POLIN Museum. A new interactive methodology for site visits was also introduced to participants during the seminar.

The trainees were satisfied by the quality of both the lectures and workshops. They much appreciated the site visits and especially the new methodology used for visiting Warsaw ghetto.
