**Description**

From November 21st to 23rd 2023, the training "Interrogating the Never Again. The Holocaust and mass atrocities: comparing to single out" was held at the Centre Universitaire Francophone of the University of Szeged, Hungary. It was co-organized by the University of Szeged (Hungary), the University of Babeş-Bolyai (Romania) and the Mémorial de la Shoah (France). During two and a half days, 36 participants from Hungary and Romania followed a training gathering historical lectures, interactive workshops and a visit of Szeged synagogue.

The trainees underlined the quality of the workshops and appreciated the efforts to implement interactive parts in order for them to express and share their ideas. However some of them would have expected more interactive times and thus meet their colleagues from the other country. They also highlighted the transnational perspective of the training that made the discussions interesting - one lecture in particular was dedicated to regional tensions between Hungarian and Romanian citizens as well as the minorities.
